## **Planning Committee**

## **Terms of Reference**

The Planning Committee is currently an advisory body to the Local Planning Authority (West Suffolk) for all planning applications that relate to the Brandon Town area.

- 1. The Committee will appoint a Chairman at their first meeting following the Annual Meeting of the Town Council each year.
- 2. In the event of the Chairman's absence from a meeting the Committee will appoint a member of the Committee to chair that meeting only.
- 3. The Committee will consist of a minimum of 5 Councillors appointed by Full Council.
- 4. A quorum will consist of 3 members.
- 5. The Committee will meet once a month, dates to be decided or when required.
- 6. Should the need arise, the Town Clerk can be asked to apply for an extension to the comment's deadline from West Suffolk.
- 7. Members of the public may attend a Planning Meeting to make representation on an application and must submit their name, address and the application reference number on arrival. Time allocated to public representation is a maximum of 20 minutes per application or at the Chairman's discretion.
- 8. Councillors may question members of the public but must not engage in discussion with them nor can they express support or objection.
- 9. On-site visits must be arranged by the Town Clerk and a minimum of 3 members must be present.
- 10. At the request of 3 members of the Full Town Council an application may be called in to be considered by the Full Council.

- 11. The decisions of the Planning Committee must be clearly minuted and given the Town Clerk to be forwarded to West Suffolk and to be presented to Full Council.
- 12. All correspondence must be conducted through the Town Clerk.
- 13. Terms of Reference will be reviewed by Full Council annually.
- 14. Subject to clause 10, Brandon Town Council Planning Committee has delegated responsibility from Full Council to make a final decision in respect of planning issues.
